PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Mission and Ethics Committee has recognized that in order for the program to succeed, the employees need to fully embrace what it means to continue to enhance the culture of our organization. The Administrative Team acknowledges the importance of “Living the Mission” as a way to recognize those employees who fulfill the promise to keep this initiative alive.

The **“Living the Mission” Award** is based on the Four (4) “Core Values” of the CHSLI Mission Statement:

- Respect
- Justice
- Integrity
- Excellence

These Core Values should be at the center of our daily work initiative. Each and every employee should make this their daily promise. Incorporating these values into our daily living will encourage a positive change in how we perform our responsibilities.

This award has been designed to recognize employees and volunteers who are **Living the Mission** of CHSLI.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- Nomination cards are completed.
- Nomination cards are validated by the Mission and Ethics Committee.
- From the validated nomination cards, one winner will be selected from all nominations.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Nomination cards are filled out completely.
- The card must contain a detailed explanation regarding how the “Core Values” are being represented.
- Candidate must be in “good standing” regarding the organization’s Policy & Procedures.

MISSION AND ETHICS COMMITTEE

- Comprised of directors, managers and staff of clinical, non-clinical areas and all offices.
- Mission and Ethics Committee will collect nomination cards on a quarterly basis from all boxes located in the facilities.
- Mission and Ethics Committee will notify department heads/managers of those nominated in their areas.

THE HONOREE WILL RECEIVE SPECIAL RECOGNITION, INCLUDING A LIVING THE MISSION CHSLI PIN

The Mission and Ethics Committee will maintain the record-keeping process of all validated nominees.

The “Living the Mission” Award is reflective of your true value as an employee who has demonstrated above and beyond dedication to CHSLI and to the care and compassion for our patients, families, and staff.

Our goal is to recognize those employees who perform their work responsibilities, strive to go above and beyond their normal workday, and take that extra effort to enhance and exemplify the “Core Values.” The Mission and Ethics Committee is confident that we can accomplish this because we know we have many CHSLI employees and volunteers who live the mission every day.
